Mag 7 is prepared to assist you in the upcoming 2010 NORRA Mexican 1000 rally-race. For over 40 years, we have been there when and where you needed us!

This race is a return to our roots and we are both excited and honored to be part of it....AGAIN

We support buggys, trucks, bikes or quads. We will have three pits on each race day. Each is equipped to fuel both high octane or pre-mix with dry breaks, jazz cans, and 11-gallon dump cans or racer supplied containers if you prefer. Race radios tuned to 153.380 are used to communicate with racers.

We will have a representative on-site in the NORRA compound on Wed. 28 April for spares drop-off. Most of our Pit Captains and crew will be in Mexicali on Thurs 29 April 2010 for spares loading. They will need to depart Mexicali no later than noon on 29 May since the Southern pits will take two days of driving to get there.

Costs for service are as follows: Car, truck, buggy: \$400.00 Bike or quad: \$200.00

Annual Membership dues are included. We are a non-profit LLC and this brings you under our banner as a member in case the unthinkable happens while you are in our pits.

Fuel is purchased from Sunoco and we add \$1.50 per gallon to haul it for you. Tell us how many gallons you want, at what pit, and it will be there!

Pit locations will be set up in conjunction with NORRA mandated checkpoints. When you enter the pit / checkpoint, the clock stops! When you depart, the clock begins again.

We will have Mag-7 signs posted 1 mile and ¼ mile before our pit, and a large banner will also be up at the pit itself.

What do you get for your money?

1. An experienced crew who are there to help you race on!
2. A long list including, hand tools, power tools, welder, CO2, jacks, electrical power etc.
3. Vital fluids such as oils and lubes.
4. Spares that you have given to us. Tires, filters, parts, food... give it to us, we will transport and stage it where you tell us.
5. Fuel. Charged separately. (cost announced by Sunoco). Tell us how much, what kind, where you want it and we will purchase it directly from Sunoco and haul it all for you.
6. Sat-phone emergency service and scheduled NORRA notification.

Why have Mag-7 provide your Pit support?

1. This is what we love to do. We have been supporting Baja racers for 42 years and are always where you need us, when you need us.
2. Reduce YOUR logistics and support costs dramatically.
3. Reduce the man-power needed for your support. We will be there! Use us to support you and solve your en-route, race-related repairs.
4. Reduce or eliminate the stress and safety issues associated with "chasing".

Flat tires, broken vehicles and running out of fuel are NOT emergencies! It is *racing*, poor planning or mechanical issues.
