



RALLY RACER ALERT

April 5, 2010

If you have studied our web-site you will notice that PCI Race Radios have been onboard with the Mexican 1000 Revival from the start. After a recent meeting with Scott Steinberger of PCI, the following communications outline has been strongly suggested. Per Scott, the following logistics apply.

*Due to the extreme distances on each day of the rally, the Weatherman Relay as we know it, will not be in effect. However **151.625** will be available to all teams, for all emergency communications, and will be monitored and supplemented by Satellite Phone relay. Satellite phone logistics will be co-ordinated by Spirit Wireless (866-728-7368/ask for Dawn Marie). We strongly recommend that for teams with sat comms. questions, contact Spirit Wireless to make arrangements for all Satellite Phone needs. In addition, PCI Race Radios are available for those in need of assistance with radio frequencies and instrument set ups. In addition PCI is available for Lowrance navigational setups. The course GPS download will be available in the next 10 days, as well as the final Route Book. However if you are having trouble loading your GPS card, PCI would be your best bet for a painless solution. Both PCI and Spirit Wireless will be in Mexicali to assist you in your needs, however, make your communications request **now** so you will not be left out in Mexico.

*Additionally Frank DeAngelo has been kind enough to bring the BFG communications satellite system to the the Rally for emergency assistance as well. All teams can can communicate to BFG on **151.715** Main.

*Mag 7, on **153.380** will be in service and available for all pit heads ups, as well as relaying by satellite phone any emergency situations that may arise.

*Checkers Off-Road is onboard as well. They will be situated at the overnight halts each night of the rally. Should you require their assistance, Checkers can be reached on **151.925**.

Over the next week, dedicated emergency Satellite Phone numbers will be published. Please be on the lookout for these updates and postings.
